#### ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR FOR BHMS SECOND YEAR SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION:

The BHMS second year students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2018-19 whose admissions are approved by the University and completed study period with 75% (SEVENTY FIVE PERCENT) attendance in each of the subjects and failed, detained and not registered for the previously held BHMS Second Year examinations are eligible to appear for the examination subject to the fulfillment of examination regulations.

- 1) The calculation of attendance percentage will be up to **15.12.2021**
- 2) The uploading of the attendance of the candidates from 28.12.2021 to 30.12.2021.
- 3) The confirmation date for attendance on **31.12.2021**.

# 4) <u>Digital Valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional</u> <u>answer booklet</u>

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For **BHMS Course** single answer booklet with **64** writable pages depending on the subject with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet of 64 writable pages only.
