

1. COURSES OFFERED (B.H.M.S)

B.H.M.S. - **BACHELOR OF HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICINE & SURGERY.** It is an undergraduate course. The course is for 4 1/2 Year study and 1 year of Internship. In the year 2023-2024 Batch 100 seats were sanctioned by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt of India.

How to apply - A candidate should complete plus two/Intermediate with minimum 50% in Biology, Physics, and Chemistry. He should the clear the Ayush Entrance Examination and join the college as per the allocation of the university. The allotments of seats are in the Convener quota in category A, B and in the Management quota in category C.

Admission capacity: 100

Eligibility:

- 1. The candidate should be an Indian National or Person of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) Card Holder and should satisfy the Local or Nonlocal status in Telangana (Residence requirement) as laid down in Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulations of Admissions) Order, 1974. Selection will be done as per the procedure laid down in the G.O.Ms.No.170HM&FW(E1) Dept
- 2. The candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology)/Biotechnology and English.
- 3. OC candidates should obtain not less than 50% marks in science subjects.
- 4. BC/SC/ST candidates should obtain not less than 40% marks in science subjects.
- 5. OC PH candidates should obtain not less than 45% marks in science subjects.
- 6. The candidates should have secured marks of cut-off scores and above in National Eligibility- cum- Entrance Test NEET UG -2023, conducted by CBSE, New Delhi.

Duration of Programme - 3 years including 1 year house job duty or equivalent thereof.

Eligibility:

The candidate should be an Indian National or Person of Indian Origin(PIO)/ Overseas Citizens of Indian (OCI) Card Holder and should satisfy the Local or Non local status in Telangana (Residence requirement) as laid down in Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974. Section will be done as per the Procedure laid down in the G.O. Ms.no.170 HM& FW(EI) Dept.

Minimum eligibility for M.D.(Hom) is BHMS course of 5 ½ years duration including 1 year compulsory rotatory internship.

Admission procedure- According to AIAPGET Merit List.

REGULATIONS OF ADMISSION AT THE COLLEGE:

The Principal of MNR HomoeopathicMedical College, shall constitute an Admission Committee of the college from Professors to verify the correctness of documents. If there is any discrepancy the provisional allotment shall be cancelled and action shall be initiated as per Rules.

- Candidates joining courses shall execute a bond on non-judicial stamp paper of value of Rs.100/- in the form specified in Annexure-I to ensure completion of the prescribed period of training or in default or for any other reason has to pay Rs.1,00,000/- to the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences. The Original certificates submitted shall not be returned to the candidates till they complete their course.
- Candidates selected to various courses shall be whole time students. Service Candidates will have to apply for study leave and are required to produce the orders wherein such leave has been sanctioned to them from the competent authority within 3 months after joining the course.

FEES:

All the selected candidates are required to pay the admission fee, tuition fees etc., as per rules in force.

- Tuition Fee: All the candidates selected are required to pay the tuition fee as prescribed by the Government. If any of the candidates who joined in a course is allotted to another course in subsequent counseling, the tuition fee paid by the candidate will be adjusted to the newly selected course and the tuition fee paid already shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- All the selected candidates shall pay the following fee in the form of crossed Demand Draft drawn on ANY NATIONALISED BANK in favor of Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences payable at Warangal on the day of selection. The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- UNIVERSITY FEE: 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousands only)
- In case of cancellation after the cutoff date mention by University the candidate have to pay 1,00,000/- to the University through DD and the whole three years Tuition fees to the College.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE:

- The post graduate students shall mandatorily complete eighty five (85%) percent of attendance in all subjects separately for eligibility to appear for the final examination.
- Leave: The Post Graduates are eligible for 30 days leave in the academic year and they can avail a maximum 10 days at a time. The balance of leave in any year shall not be carried forward to the next academic year.
- Maternity leave: Post Graduate students are eligible for maternity leave as per Government rules and the period of study shall be extended accordingly.

SANCTION OF LEAVE OF ABSENCE BEYOND 3 MONTHS AND TERMINATION OF STUDENTSHIP:

Break of study and re-admission:

If a student absents continuously for a period of 91 days or more and less than one year and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences payable at Warangal shall be forwarded to the Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Principal. Regulations for re-admission after break of study along with application format and fee payable is available in the University. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfilled the regulatory conditions, they may submit applications through the Principal of the College by paying the fee. Candidates who discontinue the course for more than one year are not eligible for readmission

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Smoking, Consumption of alcohol and narcotic drugs in the College and Hostel premises are strictly prohibited. If anyone found indulging in such acts will be liable for disciplinary action including cancellation of admission.
- 2. Ragging is strictly banned and punishable crime under Section 5 (ii) of Act No. 26 of 1997. If student violates the rules, he/she will be subjected to severe punishment under the court of law and will be debarred from the college.

Central Library: Fully air conditioned, with a seating capacity of about 950. The library is housed in an exclusive 3 storied building and has the right kind of infrastructure and facilities for students to learn. There is also 120 seating capacity Virtual Class Room, for conduction of Academic activities like CME & CD Programmes and Guest Lectures and Video Conferences. And separate IT zone for accessing e-recourses with 40 nodes and high speed Wi Fi facility. The Library has 35, 989 volumes (Medical, Dental, Physiotherapy, Homoeopathy and other related General Books) classified text books, reference books with group study area fro graduate and post graduate students, and private study area for faculty.

Hostels:

Separate accommodation for girls and boys is provided. Hostels are well furnished and maintained. PG scholars are encouraged to avail these facilities as it saves quality time which can be used more appropriately. The institution runs a mess and canteen for the UG & PG students
